- **SAT Prep Class:** CCHS will offer Saturday SAT Prep Classes prior to the **March 9th** exam. The classes will be held at CCHS on **February 2nd, February 9th, February 23rd, and March 2nd**, skipping February 16th due to the long weekend. Classes will begin at 8:30 a.m. and will end at 12:40 p.m.
 - Each class will be taught by two CCHS teachers, one from the math department and one from the English department. The class will review both the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing section and the Math section of the SAT.
