Dear Parents:

At Charlotte Catholic, student achievement is one of our primary goals. The importance of uninterrupted instructional time is directly related to student achievement. Disruptions caused by student dismissals are negatively affecting instructional time. We understand that some appointments can be scheduled only during school hours, and unexpected situations occur which necessitate the dismissal of a student during the school day, but we are requesting that all unplanned dismissals be reserved for emergencies. Effective Monday, February 11, 2019, if a dismissal is necessary, please plan for your student to be dismissed during class changes. This will reduce the number of disruptions while important instruction is taking place.

Preferred procedure for **planned** dismissals:

- The student brings a note to the attendance office before school. The note should include the student's first and last name, exact time for dismissal, parent signature, and parent phone number for verification. The student will receive a pass to be dismissed from class at the time on the note.

Procedure for **unplanned** dismissals:

- Please plan to come into the attendance office and sign your student out, or
- For student drivers: please email a photo of a note including your student's first and last name, exact time of dismissal, parent signature, and parent phone number for verification. Send the email to attendance@charlottecatholic.com or fax it to 704-716-2419.

We trust your judgment as parents to determine when it is unavoidable for a student to be dismissed during school hours; however, please make every effort to time dismissals with the end of a class period. Please call Carla Brodowicz in Attendance 704-716-2417 with any questions.

Following this letter is the daily class schedule. Please confirm with your student whether he or she has 1st, 2nd, or 3rd lunch, as this affects the afternoon schedule.

Thank you in advance for your cooperation in helping to ensure that each student receives quality instructional time.
