



## 2019 GRADUATION SCHEDULE

**Graduation Practice:** There will be a mandatory graduation practice on Monday, May 20<sup>th</sup> at 10:15 a.m. in the CCHS Gym. All seniors are expected to be at the practice. Seniors will receive their caps and gowns at graduation practice.

The schedule for seniors on Monday, May 20<sup>th</sup> will be as follows:

- Seniors will attend homeroom at 7:40 a.m.
- After homeroom, seniors will go to the Chapel for a senior Mass
- Following Mass, yearbooks will be handed out in the gym by homerooms
- A senior breakfast and yearbook signing in the cafeteria will follow
- Seniors will attend mandatory graduation practice at 10:15 a.m.
- Seniors will be dismissed for the day after graduation practice

**Baccalaureate Mass:** The Baccalaureate Mass is at 5:00 p.m., on Tuesday, May 28<sup>th</sup> at St. Matthew Catholic Church. Seniors are to be lined up at St. Matthew School Gym by 4:15 p.m. Seniors who have special parts in the Mass and all those in the choir are asked to arrive at 4:00 p.m. Seniors are to wear graduation gowns but no caps. Seniors are to wear dress clothes under their gowns. Gentlemen are to wear a light-colored dress shirt, tie, dress slacks, and dress shoes; be clean shaven; and wear no earrings. Ladies should wear a dress of modest and appropriate length and neckline. No spaghetti straps, halter tops, etc. are to be worn. Flip-flops, tennis shoes, sports shirts, jeans, shorts, etc. are inappropriate for all graduation ceremonies.

**Reception:** The Senior Family Reception will be held in the St. Matthew School Gym immediately following the Baccalaureate Mass. All are invited to the Baccalaureate Mass and Senior Family Reception.

**Awards Ceremony and Senior Luncheon:** The Awards Ceremony will take place on Wednesday, May 29<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 a.m. at St. Matthew Catholic Church. Immediately following the Awards Ceremony, there will be a **senior only** luncheon at 12:30 p.m. in the St. Matthew School Gym. All are invited to the Awards Ceremony, but the luncheon is for seniors only. Gentlemen are to wear a dress shirt, dress slacks, and dress shoes; be clean shaven; and wear no earrings. Ladies should wear a dress of modest and appropriate length and neckline or dress slacks and blouse. No spaghetti straps, halter tops, etc. are to be worn. Tennis shoes, flip-flops, jeans, shorts, etc. are inappropriate.

**Graduation:** The Graduation Ceremony will take place at Bojangles Coliseum on Friday, May 31<sup>st</sup> at 5:00 p.m. Graduates are to be at Bojangles Coliseum at 4:15 p.m. Dress clothes as outlined in the Baccalaureate Mass section are to be worn underneath their caps and gowns. Tickets are not needed to attend Graduation, and there is no limit to the number of family members and friends who may attend.
