Dear Charlotte Catholic Families,

The Catholic Schools of the Diocese of Charlotte take the health and safety of students and staff very seriously. While the United States has experienced minimal coronavirus cases to-date, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (“CDC”) is advising that domestic organizations that create an environment where large groups of people assemble (i.e. Churches, Schools, Offices, etc.), implement protocols to minimize the potential for coronavirus and flu spread and to educate on how to avoid exposure.

The Catholic Schools Office and the Risk Management Department are in constant communication regarding the plans and protocol for the spread of infectious disease. Principals are kept updated on any advisories or mandates. For our schools with nurses, communication will also be sent to them. Schools have been asked to ensure that cleaning staff take extra safety precautions and clean/sanitize visible surfaces, in particular those that are “high-touch” surfaces. Students and staff are encouraged to practice hand-washing procedures. If students display signs of illness, such as fever and cough, parents are urged to keep them home.

The Catholic Schools Office is monitoring the situation and should circumstances dictate, will notify parents of any changes necessary.
