- **Midterm Exams:** Due to the delay in the start of the school year, midterm exams have been eliminated. Charlotte Catholic will follow the MACS calendar for the end of quarter (October 22nd) and semester (January 15th.) Graduation is still scheduled for May 28, 2021.
- **Parking registration:** Parking registration is **Tuesday, August 25th** in the bottom floor of parking deck A. Students must bring the registration form and pay the \$80 registration fee through the school store in order

Important Information for Seniors and Senior Parents:

- **There will be a virtual session for seniors and senior parents Thursday, August 20** regarding the college application process including updated information regarding ACT and SAT testing. Two sessions will be offered at 9:30 AM or 6:00 PM. **These sessions are mandatory for all senior students.** They will be hosted by the CCHS Counseling Department. - **Senior Vaccinations-** From Kathie Holder, MACS School Health Director: If your pediatrician's have not informed you, there is a new North Carolina vaccine requirement for students entering the 12th grade beginning August 1, 2020.

Students are now required to have a booster dose (or second dose) of the meningitis vaccine, meningococcal conjugate vaccine or MCV4. If the first dose of the vaccine was administered on or after the 16th birthday,

the booster dose is not required. The deadline for meeting this requirement is Thursday, September 1, 2020.

Please make sure your student receives the MCV4 booster dose (if needed) and provide the health room with an updated immunization record prior to the start of school in August.

This new requirement is part of the North Carolina Immunization Law and all MACS students must be in compliance with this new law. You can visit <https://www.immunize.nc.gov/family/vaccines/meningococcal.htm> for further information about meningococcal disease, the MCV4 vaccine and NC requirements. Thank you for your attention to this very important matter.

- **Senior Formal Portraits Announcement:** If you are not able to attend your scheduled appointment, you will automatically be re-scheduled for the makeup dates. If the summer dates don't work for you, we will get you scheduled for the November date.

Dress Code for Senior Portraits: Because we don't want students sharing the photography clothing, students can choose their own outfits. **Your postcard from Prestige talked about using the drapes and tuxedo shirts, but we have made the decision at Charlotte Catholic that student's should wear their own clothing.** Boys are required to wear a jacket and tie and girls should wear an appropriate style dress.
